BY-LAW NO. 09-121

Respecting:

Removal of Part Lot Control Lots 3 to 9 Inclusive and Part of Block 27, Registered Plan No. 62M-1102, "Fontana Gardens - Phase 2"

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control. --** Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

PASSED and ENACTED this 10th day of June. 2009.

- 1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, for the purpose of creating 7 semi-detached dwelling units (shown as Parts 1 through 21, Plan 62R-18496) shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:
 - Lots 3 to 9 Inclusive and Part of Block 27, Registered Plan No. 62M-1102, in the City of Hamilton
- 3. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- 4. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 10th day of June, 2011.
