## CITY OF HAMILTON

## **BY-LAW NO. 10-150**

Respecting:

Removal of Part Lot Control Blocks 103-104 of Plan No. 62M-1135, "Ancaster Arbour"

**WHEREAS** the sub-section 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the Planning Act, provides as follows:

"(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control. --** Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, for the purpose of creating thirteen (13) street townhouse dwelling lots, shown as Parts 1-30 inclusive, including maintenance easements, shown as Parts 2, 3, 5, 6, 8, 12-14, 16, 17, 20-22, 26-28 and 30 inclusive, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-18777, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Blocks 103-104, Registered Plan No. 62M-1135, in the City of Hamilton.

- 2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- 3. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 23rd day of June, 2012.
