

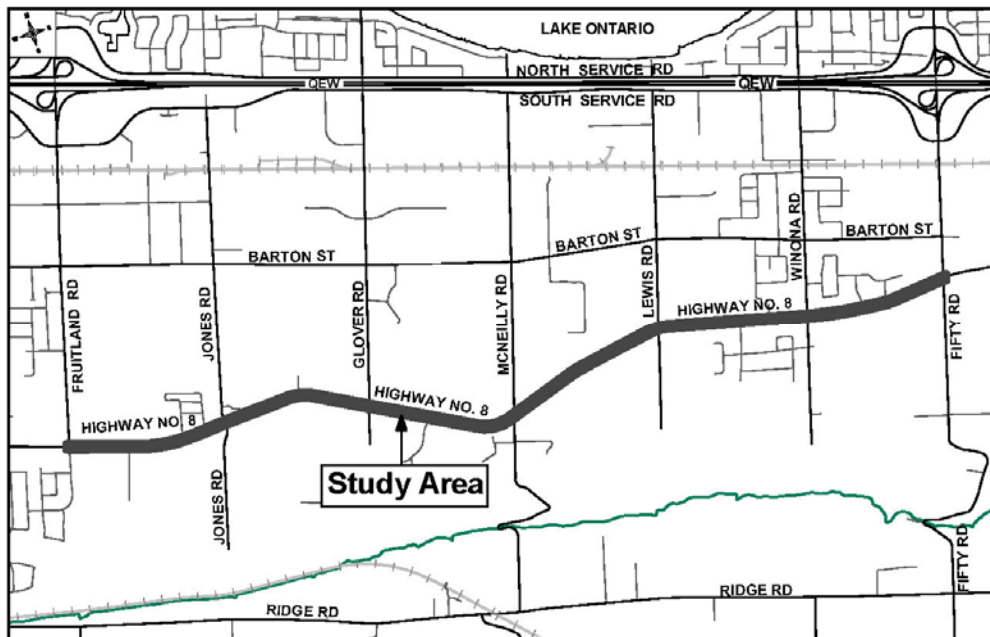


Notice of Study Commencement & Public Information Centre (PIC) #1

Highway 8 Improvements (Fruitland Road to Fifty Road) Municipal Class Environmental Assessment – Phases 3 and 4

Over the last decade, the City of Hamilton has identified ways to improve Stoney Creek's transportation system to address roadway capacity, transit services, active transportation and goods movement to accommodate future growth. Improving Highway 8 is one of the City's top priorities in Stoney Creek. As a result, the City has initiated a study to examine the need for road improvements along Highway 8 between Fruitland Road and Fifty Road (see map below). This study is being carried out as Phases 3 and 4 of a Schedule C project under the Municipal Engineers Association *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011, and 2015). Phases 1 and 2 were addressed through the Stoney Creek Urban Boundary Expansion Study and the Fruitland-Winona Secondary Plan.
