Re: Monthly Report for the month of July 2022

The Building Division report of building activity for July 2022 is enclosed for your perusal.

In July the Building Division issued 606 building permits valued at \$113.19 million.

For the month, the residential component was the strongest accounting for 71.36% of the month's total and is valued at \$80.77 million. Of the 456 permits in the residential category, 135 permits were issued for new single-family dwellings at a total value of \$49.43 million. Commercial activity accounts for 7.29% or \$8.25 million with 39 permits issued. Industrial activity accounts for 18.55% or \$21.00 million and the government and institutional activity accounts for 1.59% or \$1.80 million.

We trust these comments will aid you in the understanding of this report.
