The following information is a supplement to the previous Information Update on Snow and Ice By-law Enforcement for 2018. This update gives an overview of Licensing and By-law Services enforcement efforts in 2019.

From January 1 to March 15, 2019, Licensing and By-law Services received 2,786 complaints of By-law infraction for failing to remove snow from sidewalks. Of these complaints, 55% were found to be infractions and 1,240 Orders to Comply were issued to property owners. There was a 94% compliance rate once the order was issued with 1,163 residents clearing their snow. Licensing and By-law Services found 77 non-compliant properties that were sent to contractors for clearing.

Attached as Appendix "A" are the detailed proactive and reactive snow enforcement activities per Ward for this time period.

Although a very small percentage of orders were actually sent to contractors, many properties in violation were issued Fee for Inspection charges for non-compliance on re-inspection. However, either the snow or ice melted or property owners cleared the sidewalks before contractors could attend.
